### MY EYES WERE WIDE

as we navigated the spectacular city of Delhi with its crush of people, cars, bicycles, motorbikes, carved gods and yes, cows. At church, a little girl asked if I was a foreigner. Her mom laughed anxiously at this obvious truth—I was terribly foreign. Yet the trek was to see



a small, impactful Bible College holding classes in a rented building down a dusty, loud side road.

The Christian Leadership Development Centre (CLDC, formerly called Central Bible College) has 431 graduates, most choosing to work in the unreached regions of north India. I was granted a window into its ministry by interviewing Timothy Fund recipients, speaking in chapel and visiting the future campus site. That campus is slowly taking shape as funds allow, meanwhile students continue to minister to the most marginalized of Delhi.

It was after this life-changing exposure trip that I began to talk with Sam Vijayasenan about the need. As former faculty at that college and now pastor at Malvern Christian Assembly (Scarborough, ON), **God called Sam to take a step of faith and extend his ministry to equip leaders for the highly strategic region of northern India with some 700,000 people.**

Enter the global pandemic. As with most Bible colleges globally, CLDC was ill-prepared to take its training 100% online. Sam reached out and our team was mobilized to offer an online delivery platform. GlobalEd provides assistance to equipping institutions, such as support for online program delivery and support for students with Timothy Fund scholarships. Many challenges also needed to be overcome for students, notably reliable internet, consistent electricity, space to study with families now home and, of course, a laptop. Yet, CLDC with 44 students this fall continues equipping leaders for north India with Timothy Fund Scholarships.

The Timothy Fund has been supporting students of Lviv Theological Seminary (LTS) since 2009. From then, well over 100 young people have received an opportunity to follow their dream to receive training to become pastors and missionaries after finishing their studies at the seminary.

With the beginning of COVID, many people in Ukraine lost their jobs and prices went up because of the lockdown. Many young people from Christian families, especially those

with large families, do not have an opportunity to pay their tuition fee. **A Timothy Fund scholarship is their only chance to start or continue their theological education. These scholarship finances also have a great impact on the seminary itself, helping LTS keep working even in times of crisis.**

# Boost of Timothy Fund Scholarships in Uganda During COVID

Our college is going through a difficult time due to the impact of COVID-19. In Uganda, the government shut down all education and training institutions in March. Private education and training institutions have been gravely affected, including Pentecostal Theological College. The government has directed the re-opening of schools but we are required to put in place challenging standard operating procedures (SOP's). Procuring

the necessary items to ensure effective adherence of these SOP's requires investment.

The Timothy Fund has paid students' tuition so that we can procure these SOP's, additional chairs, tables and shelves in the library to ensure social distancing. Besides, most of our students lost their source of livelihood during months of lockdown but are now returning to the college. **This means we have to carry their struggles and try to offer as many as possible some scholarship support. Vividly, this means turning to the support from Timothy Funds. Thank you to the Canadians who make this possible!**
