Recently we have seen a dramatic increase in the demand and opportunities associated with our global equipping ministry. **The Spirit of God is answering prayers for more workers for the harvest** and we are strategically engaged to prepare those that God has called.

We have more opportunities than ever before to link arms with our network of international partners. We strengthen their ministry through consultation and project support that builds capacity for excellence in ministry training. With your generosity, we provide much needed scholarship support for students preparing for ministry. **Last year the Timothy Fund**

Scholarships assisted over 300 students to access training for ministry provided through our global partners.

Together we are addressing the critical gap in ministry training. GlobalEd is **providing equipping for those who have had, till now, no access to training**, leaning into new adult learning models and the opportunities associated with non-formal training. The Ministry Essentials Training Program (METP) has now been launched in 14 locations and is poised to equip thousands of church planters. Your support has helped to finance the translation work needed to train church planters around the world. METP will be translated into 16 languages by the end of 2022.

Together we respond to the need for biblically based leadership training that produces **transformational leaders that serve**. The Quest Leadership program has been established to address the global need for leadership that is driven to serve God and others. This produces godly leaders not only for the church but for all sectors of society.

In addition to training PAOC global workers to serve on mission with God, GlobalEd joins hands with international fellowships that are eager to send those God has called to cross-cultural mission work, sharing the wisdom and skills that God has helped us to learn with leaders and **workers of a new global mission force** through Light for the Nations.

In a worldwide **pandemic of character and integrity deficiency**, Quest is equipping **church and marketplace leaders** to pursue character formation, spiritual development, and leadership excellence.

Quest's priority is to encourage **inter-generational** leaders to journey toward a legacy of effective, efficient, and vitalized leadership. It is delivered in a non-formal leadership training program consisting of **onsite conferences and online courses**.

Quest is conducting a series of conferences with the Church of Pentecost in **Pakistan**, reaching literally thousands of

leaders through social media platforms. In **India**, Quest is forming a core team of church and Bible college leaders who will strategically introduce the program to local churches and existing Bible college curriculum to enable:

- Visibility with the communities they serve.
- Flexibility of a program offered through Zoom, onsite conferences, online courses and the training of trainers.
- Expandability of influence by leading this vital, relevant and contextualized leadership program.

Together We Can Train Pastors

Denominations globally are requesting this 120-hour portable training. When the Ministry Essentials Training Program (METP) was piloted in **English** in the Philippines and Nigeria, no one could have guessed the magnitude of the training gap that was being addressed.

METP is now translated into **Urdu** for instructors who taught 114 students in Lahore, Pakistan. In Chad, 164 students took the program in **French**. One of those students is a bi-vocational pastor of a small rural church and high school teacher who, like untold numbers of pastors globally, wants to give leadership to the people in otherwise **unreached places**. METP allows them to do this well.

With METP now in **Thai and Spanish**, it is being launched in Thailand and the Dominican Republic. Pan Africa Christian College in Zimbabwe has begun using METP to train pastors and leaders who cannot attend the College.

The Pentecostal Assemblies of Bangladesh will be training 3,700 house leaders with METP in the **Bangla** language. Other translations such as **Bahasa, Mandarin, Laotian, Malayalam, and Telegu** are underway.

Together, we can equip pastors who cannot attend a Bible College so they too can fulfill God's call on their lives.

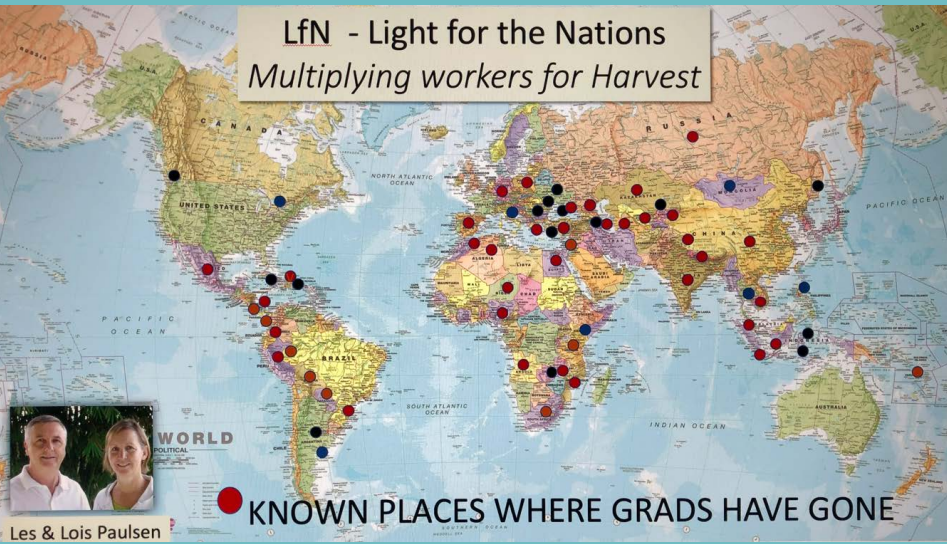
Equipping for Cross-Cultural Ministry

Since 2003, Light for the Nations (LfN), a global roving missions equipping team, has provided pre-field preparation for cross-cultural life and ministry. Here are just a few of the impact statements from students (real names not used for security reasons).

Ukraine – “I was mobilizing churches for missions and had a certain understanding, but it was not enough. In Ukraine, only LfN was preparing missionaries for unreached people groups - it deepened my understanding, gave me new tools, and **grounded my vision in God's Word**” (Ivan).

Spain – “We took LfN after eight years overseas. LfN addressed many issues missing in our training. Before, I thought missions was important just because Jesus gave us the Great Commission; now I realize it is the central teaching of Scripture, fulfilling God's purposes for the nations, and now we **intentionally pursue engaging others in missions**” (Lucia).

SE Asia (restricted context) – “LfN was of great value in many ways! One main thing was how contextual it was - the location, courses, meaningful time with like-minded workers helped me to understand that the **life of service is all-encompassing!**” (Sirpong)

Together, we equipped ministry-track students with over 300 scholarships last year, students like Audrey in Zimbabwe. When she enrolled for pastoral ministry studies, her attendance was spotty as she struggled to come up with tuition. As Audrey put it, "**Heaven opened a way for me** through a Timothy Fund Scholarship."

As a result, she was able to complete her studies and **plant a church** in her hometown.

Audrey reports, "this helped the community especially in this pandemic where the bereaved need comfort, the young need encouragement and everyone is in need of hope." Audrey is also grateful to coordinate the children's ministry in her region.

In her words, "Thank you so much *Timothy Scholarship Fund*. Continue to reach out especially to the less privileged and the struggling. I am a living testimony of your generosity, love and support."
