


Canwood Pentecostal Church is located in the community of Canwood, in Northern Saskatchewan.

CPC is affiliated with the Pentecostal Assemblies of Canada. Founded in 1919, we've been part of the community of Canwood for 106 years with a rich heritage of God moving in the fellowship. We are a multi-generational church with a lot of young people. Our focus the last 2 years has been "Growing Together".

On a typical Sunday morning we have 80-100 people in attendance, with 50% being 25 and under in age.
