Role Summary

The Discipleship Director will play a crucial role in advancing Hope City Church's mission of reaching 1% of Edmonton and helping them make the best decision of their life, which is to follow Jesus, by providing leadership to adult discipleship programs. This role is responsible for building and overseeing systems that promote spiritual growth in adults across all campuses and empowering department staff to carry out their roles effectively.

Key Responsibilities

- <u>Develop and implement discipleship systems</u>: Create and execute comprehensive discipleship strategies, programs, and initiatives to foster spiritual growth and development among adults across Hope City campuses. This will include re-evaluating, implementing, and overseeing a discipleship strategy.
- <u>Staff Oversight</u>: Provide leadership and oversight to the Care department and staff.

Key Tasks:

- <u>Small group ministry:</u> Develop and implement a dynamic small group ministry that fosters community, engagement, and spiritual growth across all Hope City Church campuses.
- <u>Resource management:</u> Oversee resources related to the discipleship department, ensuring efficient resource allocation and alignment with the church's overall mission and vision.
- <u>Programs</u>: Collaborate with the lead team to create new initiatives and execute existing ones, including workshops, courses, and events that facilitate spiritual growth.
- <u>Volunteer Engagement</u>: Recruit, train, and equip volunteers to support various discipleship initiatives, fostering a culture of volunteerism within the church.
- <u>Mentorship and counselling</u>: Offer individual or group mentoring to church members seeking spiritual guidance. Provide counselling and support for those facing personal or spiritual challenges.
- <u>Outreach and Service opportunities:</u> Encourage and facilitate opportunities for church members to engage in community service and mission work alongside our Central Services Director.

- This role requires availability on Sunday mornings and some evenings for special events or meetings.
- Agreement with our church's <u>core beliefs</u> and a commitment to our mission as evidenced by regular attendance and active participation in our church community is an ongoing condition of employment for all employees of Hope City Church.
