The Family Counsellor will work as a multidisciplinary team member and provide various assessment and treatment services for individuals and families, particularly children & Youth.

The Family Counsellor provides assessments and one-to-one counselling utilizing a variety of traditional and modern therapies. In addition to delivering clinical-focused therapies, the Family Counsellor provides referrals and consultation with other professionals who may assist the client toward wholeness.

The Family Counsellor collaborates with other healthcare providers and community service providers to ensure a continuum of care in the community.
