The church was established in a Weyburn area home in 1974 under the name of Weyburn Pentecostal Assembly. In two years, they moved into their own building and the mortgage was paid in full in 1981. By 2006 the building was bursting at the seams. The decision was made to sell and rent space from a school for a few years, with the intention that new facilities would be built at some point.

It was also at this time that the church name was changed to better reflect the purpose in the community. During the time at the school, the church committed to serve together, put in some hard teamwork, and became proficient at cleaning, set-up and take-down. Just into the new year of 2019 renovations began on the current church building. Again, the church, plus family and friends, worked together to transform the building into the lovely space Life Centre now calls home; located at 96 - 17th Street.

For the Lead Pastor

Life Centre Church is looking to hire a Lead Pastor to come along side the church leaders and church community in reaching the wider Weyburn and area community for Christ.

- Care for the church community personally, be an encourager while providing, personal development opportunities, and a healthy team environment
- Leadership in planning weekly Sunday services and delivery of messages
- Embrace and provide feedback to and from the leadership when applicable
- Assist in the planning and execution of holiday and special events as required to meet the needs of the church community
- Have a mission focus that helps to enhance community outreach and the One Stop India missions work done through Life Centre Church
- Take responsibility and opportunity to further develop through courses, seminars and PAOC conferences
- Consider work/life balance to be an important part of this position
