


BROSSARD EVANGELISTIC CENTRE Church Profile 2023

City Population

The population of Brossard, according to Statistics Canada's 2021 Census was **91,525** of which:

- 47% were of a visible minority
- 13% were only English Speaking
- · 61% spoke both English & French
- · 42.8 % was the Median Age
- \$72,570 was the Median Household Income


BEC's History

Chart of age ranges (In years)




