## **Our Church:**

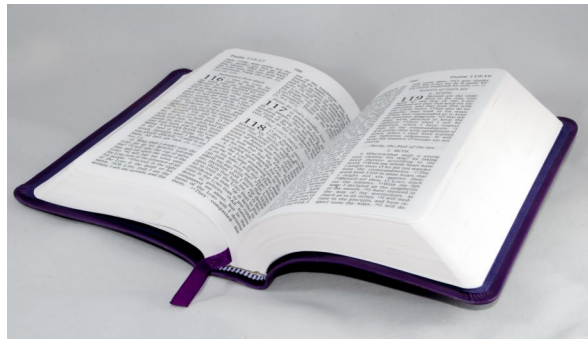
There was a vision to establish a church in the triad area and land was purchased near Pilot Butte. In our humble beginnings we rented the gymnasium at the local school for services from 2011-2013. A house was purchased adjacent to the school where we held Junior and Senior Youth activities. Eventually in 2014 a decision was made to move to the “house” to hold our Sunday Services. Plans were then put in place to sell the property, demolish the garage to build a Sanctuary which would hold 90 people. The building was completed in 2022 and we are thankful to God that our church is mortgage free. Our congregation is made up of people from Odessa, Edenwold, Emerald Park, Pilot Butte and Regina.

## **What it's Like to Live in Pilot Butte, Saskatchewan:**

We are a town of approximately 2638 residents, a community set to grow in the future. In a five-year period from 2016-21, the census showed Pilot Butte grew 23.4 percent. Pilot Butte, just 8 miles East of Regina, boasts a small-town atmosphere with the benefit of amenities either in town, nearby in Emerald Park or Regina and is a great place to raise a family.

Pilot Butte offers many services: doctor, pharmacy, restaurants, grocery store, gas station and insurance agent among the town's business sector. Pilot Butte is also home to a branch of the Southeast Regional Library, Canada Post Office, hockey rink, spray park, skate park, soccer field, four outstanding ball diamonds – one of which has lights for night games, a Lion's Club, senior's centre and rodeo grounds which hosts a rodeo annually on Father's Day, a monthly News & Views publication highlighting current events and town business. Also available are walking paths and The Butte itself is a centre for winter fun, offering great tobogganing opportunities for families to enjoy.
