Education/Experience: A successful candidate must have 2-3 years of ministry experience in a larger church setting, formal theological training, and a passion for next-gen and connections ministries.

Young Adults Expectations: Approximately 60% Of Time

1. Oversee the Young Adults Ministry, which includes providing vision to its leadership team, worship teams, life groups, and other ministry-related teams.
2. Speak at least two (2) times a month at Young Adults, making sure you are the primary voice of this ministry, providing guidance and inspiration to those 18-29 on their spiritual journey.
3. Ensure the equipping of Young Adults as leaders to make disciples, using their spiritual gifts.
4. Assist in administering the ordinances of the church.
5. Provide leadership to the assimilation & discipling process of all those in this department.
6. Equip young adults to be active in the life of the church and to take up leadership roles and responsibilities.
7. Provide pastoral care and counselling for Young Adults.

Online Ministry Coordinator: Approximately 25%

1. Lead the development and implementation of the church's online ministry strategy.
2. Oversee the planning and execution of online worship services, including sermon streaming and interactive elements.
3. Manage the scheduling and coordination of volunteers involved in online ministry activities.
4. Coordinate with technical staff to ensure the smooth operation of streaming equipment and online platforms.

Assimilation Ministry Expectations: Approximately 15% Of Time

1. Assist with the Assimilation Process at BP CHURCH, which includes:
 - Coordinate with other ministries to cultivate the next steps for newcomers to BP Church.
 - Assisting with the Hospitality Ministry (Ushers, Greeters and Welcome Centre)
 - Coordinate community-building events through our Community Care Group Ministry.
